The Pan African Lawyers Union welcomes you to Arusha for its Annual conference and Tri-Annual General Meeting.

Please find some information and tips below for your information:

#### 1.0 CONFERENCE VENUE:

The Annual Conference will take place at the Mount Meru Hotel in Arusha. It is an oasis of tranquillity on Tanzania's gateway to major tourist destinations regardless of the season. The hotel comprises of 178 guest rooms and suites, 2 restaurants, 2 bars, 24-hour in-room dining service, an outdoor swimming pool and a well-equipped gymnasium. ### 2.0 VISA

## 2.1. Visa-free entry

The United Republic of Tanzania, grants visa-free entre, to nationals of certain countries. To find out if you qualify for visa-free entry, please check the government's list, HERE.

#### 2.2. Ordinary visas

If you do not qualify for visa-free entry into Tanzania, you would have to optain anordinary visa





(Single Entry visa). This visa is granted to foreign nationals for the purposes of tourism, leisure, attending conferences, humanitarian and charity activities, family visit, health treatment or any other purpose as may be determined by the issuing authority. Its validity does not exceed 90 days for a single entry.

An application for an Ordinary Visa should be accompanied by the following;

- Copy of the applicant's valid passport (biographic data page);
- Return flight ticket;
- Duly completed declaration form
- 50 USD visa fee.

Although the Ordinary visas can be gotten on arrival, we recommend obtaining one, online, prior to your departure. This is to avoid the visa processing queues, at the airport.

## 2.3. Referral visas

Tanzania has a total of 28 countries whose nationals require referral visas, that is, countries whose nationals may not obtain visa on arrival. For a list of Countries whose nationals require a referral visa, please click HERE.

An application for a Referral visa should be accompanied by the following:

- A covering letter from a legally registered Institution/ Company if the visit is official(PALU will provide this document);
- Applicant Valid copy of Passport;
- Applicant Passport size photo;
- Copy of the host institution/Company registration documents, like Certificate of Incorporation, TIN, Business License, etc (PALU will provide this document to you);
- Filled-in Security Bond (T.I.F 12) (PALU will provide this document)
- Respective Visa fee

## 3.0. LOCAL TRANSFERS, ACCOMMODATION, MEALS AND OTHER INCIDENTALS

## 3.1. Airport Transfers

From Kilimanjaro International Airport (KIA) to Arusha City centre, airport transfers cost about 50 USD.

#### 3.0 LANGUAGE

The working languages of the meeting will be English and French with Simultaneous interpretation provided. All working documents will be in English and French.

#### 4.0 HEALTH

#### 5.1. Yellow Fever Vaccination

All visitors coming to the United Republic of Tanzania should be in possession of a valid yellow fever vaccination certificate.

## 5.2. COVID-19 Requirement

All international passengers to Tanzania must complete an online Health Survey within 24 hours of arrival.

Fully vaccinated passengers are exempt from pre-departure testing requirements. Passengers will be required to present a valid vaccination certificate with a QR code for verification upon arrival. The only acceptable vaccines are those approved by the Ministry of Health of Tanzania and the WHO.

Passengers who are not fully vaccinated, or unvaccinated and those not eligible for vaccination due to their country's policy, will be required to present a negative Covid 19 RT PCR (Real-Time Polymerase Chain Reaction) or NAATs (Nucleic Acid Amplification Tests) certificate with a QR code obtained within 72 hours before departure.







Passengers arriving from certain countries experiencing variants of interest and high Covid-19 case numbers are obliged to take a rapid antigen test on arrival in Tanzania, at their own expense (USD 10 for Tanzania Mainland). If found positive, they will be tested with RT PCR for confirmation and will be required to self-isolate. The list of countries for which rapid antigen testing is required can be found HERE. #### 5.0 WEATHER

The temperatures in Arusha in June range from 18°C to 28°C. The weather will be cool with rain but can get chilly at night. We strongly suggest you carry appropriate clothing. For more information, click HERE.

#### 6.0 CURRENCY

The currency of Tanzania is known as the Tanzanian Shilling (TZS or TSH).

Most hotels will exchange US dollars, Euros and British Pounds for Tanzanian Shillings. Other currencies, such as Canadian or Australian dollars, may be accepted but at rates far below the going rate. ATMs are mostly located in the city centre. Credit Cards can only be used in large hotels, resorts, and with certain travel agents.

The exchange rate is about USD \$ 1 - 2300 TZS.

#### 7.0 ELECTRICITY VOLTAGE

Tanzania uses one associated plug type, type G. Plug type G is the plug that has two flat parallel pins and a grounding pin. Tanzania operates on a 230V supply voltage and 50Hz.







## 8.0 SECURITY

Arusha is a very quiet and well-secured city. However, delegates should take sensible precautions to protect themselves and their belongings. Where possible, avoid carrying all your important documents, huge sums of money, passport and other valuables in the same bag.

Keep valuables in a secure place, and a good recommendation is only to carry enough cash for your immediate requirements and



only one credit or bank card. Keep your belongings under your supervision.

NB: All types of `carrier/grocery plastic bags used for commercial and household packaging have been banned in Tanzania. Please ensure you do not bring them into Tanzania nor purchase them while in Tanzania as there are heavy fines in place. Examples of household plastic bags are disposable, grocery, carrier, sealable, zip locks (except to carry toiletries), packaging, and any kind of consumer plastic bags. More details
